1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 121A.12] NATIONAL MOTTO.

1.6 (a) To the extent funds or in-kind contributions are available under paragraph (b), a
1.7 school board or charter school may prominently display in a conspicuous place in each
1.8 school an easily readable durable poster, framed copy, or mounted plaque of the national
1.9 motto of the United States, "In God We Trust."

1.10 (b) A school board or charter school may accept nonpublic funds or in-kind contributions
1.11 to implement this section.
