1.8	requiring a minimum of 30 minutes of instruction, beginning January 1, 2007, relating to
1.9	organ and tissue donations and the provisions of section 171.07, subdivision 5, for persons

1.11	commercial driver training schools.
1.12	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules for persons enrolled in driver education programs

1.15	interaction with commercial motor vehicle traffic. The rules must require classroom

1.17	distances, proper distances for following trucks, identification of truck blind spots, and
1.18	avoidance of driving in truck blind spots.
1.19	(c) By January 1, 2012, the commissioner shall adopt rules for persons enrolled in driver
1.20	education programs offered at public schools, private schools, and commercial driver training
1.21	schools, requiring inclusion in the course of instruction of a section on carbon monoxide
1.22	poisoning. The instruction must include but is not limited to (1) a description of the
