Subd. 4. **Participant eligibility.** A candidate is eligible to participate in the program established under this section if the candidate:

(1) holds an associate degree in a content-specific career and technical education field;

(2) has an industry recognized, professional credential in a content-specific career and technical education field; or

(3) has five years and a minimum of 5,000 hours of verifiable work experience in a career and technical education content-specific field.

Subd. 5. **Report required.** The chancellor of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system must submit an annual report by January 15 of each year on the progress of its activities under this section to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over higher education and kindergarten through grade 12 education, the commissioner of education, the commissioner of higher education, and the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities. The annual report must include career and technical education content-specific fields of study offered, enrollment numbers, number of degrees granted, and placement data. The first report is due no later than January 15, 2021.
