2.13 fund under section 299A.705.

2.15 services operating account in the special revenue fund under section 299A.705.

2.16 ~~(g)~~ (h) Fees and the deposit of the fees for accident records and reports are governed by  
2.17 section 169.09, subdivision 13.

2.19 Subd. 2. **Requests for information; surcharge on fee.** (a) Except as otherwise provided  
2.20 in subdivision 3, the commissioner shall impose a surcharge of 50 cents on each fee charged  
2.21 by the commissioner under section 13.03, subdivision 3, for copies or electronic transmittals  
2.22 of public information about the registration of a vehicle or an applicant, or holder of a  
2.23 driver's license, instruction permit, or Minnesota identification card.

2.24 (b) The surcharge only applies to a fee imposed in response to a request made in person  
2.25 or by mail, or to a request for transmittal through a computer modem. The surcharge does  
2.26 not apply to the request of (1) an individual for information about that individual's driver's  
2.27 license, instruction permit, or Minnesota identification card or about vehicles registered or  
2.28 titled in the individual's name; or (2) a trade association performing a member service under  
2.29 section 604.15, subdivision 4a, by inquiring into a record to obtain information about the  
2.30 owner of a motor vehicle who violated section 604.15, subdivision 2.

2.31 (c) The surcharges collected under this subdivision must be credited to the general fund.
