for a grant to the Stearns County Attorney's Office to coordinate and expand targeted law enforcement, prosecutorial, and victim advocacy resources of the Central Minnesota Sex Trafficking Task Force for sex trafficking investigation, enforcement, prosecution, and victim advocacy services. This appropriation is available through June 30, 2019.
