1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 97A.475, subdivision 20, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 20. **Trapping license.** The fee for a license to trap fur-bearing animals is:

1.9 (1) for residents over age 13 and under age 18, \$6;

1.10 (2) for residents age 18 or over and under age 65, \$20;

1.11 (3) for residents age 65 or over, \$10; and

1.12 (4) for nonresidents, ~~\$73~~ \$200.

1.13 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 97B.601, subdivision 3a, is amended to read:

1.14 Subd. 3a. **Nonresidents; trapping small game.** A nonresident may take small

1.15 game by trapping ~~only on land owned by the nonresident,~~ if the nonresident possesses a

1.16 trapping license and a small game license.
