1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to state government; requiring state appointing authorities to use the  
 1.3 federal E-Verify program; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,  
 1.4 chapter 43A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [43A.145] E-VERIFY.

1.7 Appointing authorities in the legislative, executive, and judicial branches must use  
 1.8 the federal E-Verify program for all newly hired employees. The commissioner must  
 1.9 oversee training for executive branch appointing authorities on the use of E-Verify,  
 1.10 and must conduct periodic audits of executive branch appointing authorities to ensure  
 1.11 compliance with this section.
