BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. MINNESOTA STATE ACADEMIES.
- 1.7

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$15,259,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
- 1.8

fund to the commissioner of administration for the following projects on the campuses of
- 1.9

the Minnesota State Academies:
- 1.10

(1) \$3,090,000 is for capital asset preservation improvements and betterments
- 1.11

on both campuses of the Minnesota State Academies, to be spent in accordance with
- 1.12

Minnesota Statutes, section 16B.307;
- 1.13

(2) \$10,669,000 is to demolish Frechette Hall, and to design, construct, furnish, and
- 1.14

equip a new dormitory for the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf; and
- 1.15

(3) \$1,500,000 is to complete renovation of Pollard Hall at the Minnesota State
- 1.16

Academy for the Deaf.
- 1.17

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
- 1.18

bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
- 1.19

bonds of the state in an amount up to \$15,259,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
- 1.20

the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
- 1.21

Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
