1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION COSTS STUDY; APPROPRIATION.
1.6	(a) \$ is appropriated in fiscal year 2018 from the general fund to the commissioner
1.7	of transportation for a study on highway construction costs. The commissioner shall enter
1.8	into an agreement to conduct the study with an organization or entity having relevant
1.9	expertise.
1.10	(b) At a minimum, the study must include:
1.11	(1) an overview of highway construction cost issues;
1.12	(2) comparison of costs in Minnesota relative to other states and regions;
1.13	(3) identification of factors specific to Minnesota, if any, that contribute to cost
1.14	differences;
1.15	(4) evaluation of the methodology used for highway construction cost calculation and
1.16	indexing in Minnesota, including review of associated best practices; and
1.17	(5) specific recommendations for road authorities and legislative changes to reduce
1.18	highway construction costs.
1.19	(c) By February 15, 2018, the commissioner shall submit a report on the study to the
1.20	chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over
1.21	transportation policy and finance.
