A bill for an act 1.1 relating to the Washington County Housing and Redevelopment Authority; 1.2 clarifying the jurisdiction of the authority; amending Laws 1974, chapter 475, 1.3 sections 1; 2, subdivision 1; 3. 1.4 1.5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1974, chapter 475, section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. WASHINGTON COUNTY; HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT **AUTHORITY.**

There is hereby created in Washington county a public body corporate and politic, to be known as the Washington County Housing and Redevelopment Authority, having all the powers and duties of a housing and redevelopment county authority under the provisions of the municipal housing and redevelopment act, Minnesota Statutes, sections 462.411 to 462.711, and acts amendatory thereof; which act applies 469.001 to 469.047, and all powers of a county housing and redevelopment authority under any other provisions of Minnesota law, and Minnesota Statutes, sections 469.001 to 469.047 apply to the county of Washington. For the purposes of applying the provisions of the municipal housing and redevelopment act to Washington county, the county has all of the powers and duties of a municipality, the county board has all of the powers and duties of a governing body, the chairman of the county board has all the powers and duties of a mayor, and the area of operation includes the area within the territorial boundaries of the county.
