The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment, Energy and Natural Resources Policy and Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital improvements; appropriating money for a drainage outlet for
1.3 Lake Oscar; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **LAKE OSCAR, DOUGLAS COUNTY.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$300,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7 fund to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to Douglas County for
1.8 construction of a gated 24-inch drainage outlet for Lake Oscar. The new drainage outlet
1.9 will be located parallel to an existing 18-inch drainage outlet on land for which Douglas
1.10 County holds an easement. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of
1.11 management and budget has determined that at least \$10,000 has been secured for this
1.12 project from nonstate sources.

1.13 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.14 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.15 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$300,000, in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.16 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.17 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
