1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to agriculture; modifying noncommercial pesticide applicator fee for
1.3 certain licensees; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 18B.34, subdivision
1.4 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 18B.34, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. Fees. (a) A person initially applying for or renewing a noncommercial applicator
1.8 license must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$50, except an applicant who is a
1.9 government or Conservation Corps Minnesota employee who uses pesticides in the course
1.10 of performing official duties must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$10.

1.11 (b) For the fee required under paragraph (a), a government employee, a contractor
1.12 providing rest area custodial services for the commissioner of transportation, or a
1.13 Conservation Corps Minnesota employee is eligible for a reduced fee of \$10 if the employee
1.14 or contractor uses pesticides in the course of performing official duties.

1.15 (b) (c) A license renewal application received after March 1 in the year for which the
1.16 license is to be issued is subject to a penalty fee of 50 percent of the application fee. The
1.17 penalty fee must be paid before the renewal license may be issued.

1.18 (e) (d) An application for a duplicate noncommercial applicator license must be
1.19 accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee of \$10.
