1.7	who as part of the employee's job duties:
1.8	(1) has access to uses labor relations information as that term is defined in section
1.9	13.37, subdivision 1, paragraph (c); or
1.10	(2) actively participates in the meeting and negotiating on behalf of the public
1.11	employer.
1.12	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
