- 1.2 relating to elections; prohibiting the conduct of special primaries and special
- 1.3 elections on certain days; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections 204D.19,
- 1.4 subdivision 2; 204D.195.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 204D.19, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 2. **Special election when legislature will be in session.** Except for vacancies in
- 1.8 the legislature which occur at any time between the last day of session in an odd-numbered
- 1.9 year and the 40th day prior to the opening day of session in the succeeding even-numbered
- 1.10 year, when a vacancy occurs and the legislature will be in session so that the individual
- 1.11 elected as provided by this section could take office and exercise the duties of the office
- 1.12 immediately upon election, the governor shall issue within five days after the vacancy occurs
- 1.13 a writ calling for a special election. The special election shall be held as soon as possible,
- 1.14 consistent with the notice requirements of section 204D.22, subdivision 3, but in no event
- 1.15 more than 35 days after the issuance of the writ. ~~A special election must not be held during~~
- 1.16 ~~the four days before or the four days after a holiday as defined in section 645.44, subdivision~~

- 1.18 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 204D.195, is amended to read:
- 1.19 **204D.195 DATE OF SPECIAL ELECTION; CERTAIN TIMES PROHIBITED.**
- 1.20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a special primary and special general election
- 1.21 may not be held:

2.1 (1) for a period beginning the day following the date of the state primary election and
2.2 ending the day prior to the date of the state general election; or

2.3 (2) on a holiday, or during the four days before or the four days after a holiday, as defined
2.4 in section 645.44, subdivision 5.

2.5 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2.6 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following enactment and apply to special elections
2.7 for vacancies in office occurring on or after that date.
