BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. EXONERATION AWARDS.
\$108,684.65 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
of management and budget for full payment of awards of damages under the Imprisonment
and Exoneration Remedies Act, Minnesota Statutes, sections 611.362 to 611.368, to Nicholas
Mark Peterson. This appropriation is available until June 30, 2022.
Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS; APPROPRIATION.
(a) The amounts in this paragraph are appropriated from the general fund to the
commissioner of corrections in fiscal year 2022 for full and final payment under Minnesota
Statutes, sections 3.738 and 3.739, of claims against the state for losses suffered while
incarcerated in a state correctional facility or for injuries suffered by and medical services
provided to persons injured while performing community service or sentence-to-service
work for correctional purposes or while incarcerated in a state correctional facility. This
appropriation is available until June 30, 2022:
(1) for sentence-to-service and community work service claims under \$7,000 and other
claims already paid by the department, \$1,180.63;
(2) for payment to Nicholas Edwards for permanent injuries to his right index finger
while performing assigned duties at Minnesota Correctional Facility - Moose Lake, \$3,940;
