1.12	(3) separation from employment as a committee administrator for a legislative caucus.
1.13	(b) The two-year prohibition on registering as a lobbyist under paragraph (a) does not
1.14	apply to lobbying as:
1.15	(1) an employee of the state;
1.16	(2) a nonelected local official;
1.17	(3) an employee of a political subdivision; or
1.18	(4) a volunteer lobbyist.
