1.6	Section 1. [17.119] TRACTOR ROLLOVER PROTECTION PILOT GRANT
1.7	PROGRAM.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Grants; eligibility. (a) The commissioner must award cost-share
1.9	grants to Minnesota farmers who retrofit eligible tractors with eligible rollover protective
1.10	structures. Grants are limited to 70 percent of the farmer's documented cost to purchase,
1.11	ship, and install an eligible rollover protective structure. The commissioner must increase
1.12	the grant award amount over the 70 percent grant limitation requirement if necessary to
1.13	limit a farmer's cost per tractor to no more than \$500.
1.14	(b) A rollover protective structure is eligible if it meets or exceeds SAE International
1.15	standard J2194.
1.16	(c) A tractor is eligible if the tractor was built before 1987.
1.17	Subd. 2. Promotion; administration. The commissioner may spend up to 20
1.18	percent of total program dollars each fiscal year to promote the program to Minnesota
1.19	farmers. The commissioner must minimize administrative costs by cooperating with the
1.20	New York Center for Agricultural Medicine and Health to administer the grant program.
1.21	Subd. 3. Nonstate funds; appropriation. The commissioner must solicit
1.22	contributions from nonstate sources to supplement state appropriations for this program.
