- 1.2 relating to the secretary of state; creating a technology and cybersecurity account;
- 1.3 providing for technology and cybersecurity maintenance; proposing coding for
- 1.4 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 5.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[5.42] TECHNOLOGY AND CYBERSECURITY ACCOUNT.**
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) For purposes of this section, the terms defined in this
- 1.8 subdivision have the meanings given them.
- 1.9 (b) "Information and telecommunications technology systems and services" has the
- 1.10 meaning given in section 16E.03, subdivision 1, paragraph (a).
- 1.11 (c) "Cybersecurity" has the meaning given in section 16E.03, subdivision 1, paragraph
- 1.12 (e).
- 1.13 Subd. 2. **Account.** (a) The secretary of state may retain two percent of all fees collected
- 1.14 by the secretary of state by law to be used for costs related to the maintenance and
- 1.15 enhancement of the secretary of state's (1) information and telecommunications technology
- 1.16 systems and services, and (2) for cybersecurity capabilities.
- 1.17 (b) Money received under this subdivision must be deposited in an account in the special
- 1.18 revenue fund and is annually appropriated to the secretary of state for purposes of this
- 1.19 subdivision.
