The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money to renovate the five historic
1.3 sites in Cook County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. RENOVATION HISTORIC SITES; COOK COUNTY.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,092,650 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Cook County
1.8 for the following purposes:

1.9 (1) to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation of the following
1.10 Historic Cook County sites: (i) the Cook County History Museum; (ii) the Johnson Heritage
1.11 Post Art Gallery; (iii) the Bally Blacksmith Shop; (iv) the St. Francis Xavier Church, also
1.12 known as the Chippewa City Church; and (v) 1930s Nee-Gee Fishing Tug and Fish House;
1.13 and

1.14 (2) to complete design for and to construct, furnish, and equip a new collections storage
1.15 facility in Cook County.

1.16 This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines
1.17 that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by
1.18 Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.19 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.20 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.21 the state in an amount up to \$1,092,650 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
