1.6 Section 1. [237.122] PERSONAL INFORMATION; PROHIBITION.

1.7 A telecommunications or Internet service provider that has entered into a franchise

agreement, right-of-way agreement, or other contract with the state of Minnesota or a political subdivision, or that uses facilities that are subject to such agreements even if it is not a party to the agreement, is prohibited from collecting personal information from a customer resulting from the customer's use of the telecommunications or Internet service provider without express written approval from the customer. A telecommunication or Internet service provider is prohibited from refusing to provide its services to a customer on the grounds that the customer has not approved collection of the customer's personal information.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
