- 1.7\$1,744,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$2,049,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from
- 1.8the general fund to the commissioner of human services for additional staff and associated
- 1.9costs in the Office of Ombudsman for Long-Term Care. The additional staff must include
- 1.10ten full-time regional ombudsmen, two full-time supervisors, and five additional full-time
- 1.11support staff.
