1.7	Subdivision 1. Definitions. As used in this section:
1.8	(1) "place of public accommodation" has the meaning given in section 363A.03,
1.9	subdivision 34; and
1.10	(2) "service animal" has the meaning given in section 343.20, subdivision 7.
1.11	Subd. 2. Crime described. A person who, with the intent of wrongfully obtaining money
1.12	property, access to a place of public accommodation, or any other tangible benefit, falsely
1.13	represents to another through statements or conduct that an animal the person owns or
1.14	controls is a service animal when the animal is not, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
1.15	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2018, and applies to crimes
1.16	committed on or after that date.
