Section 1. [197.69] VETERAN'S SURVIVOR GRANT PROGRAM.

The commissioner of veterans affairs shall establish a grant program to provide assistance to an eligible surviving spouse of a veteran. A surviving spouse is eligible for assistance through this grant program if the spouse was married to a veteran who died prior to completing the forms required to provide for ongoing survivor benefits. An eligible spouse must apply for assistance to the commissioner as required by the commissioner, according to the timelines established and providing all necessary information as determined by the commissioner.
