1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; ARTS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE FUND.
1.6	\$800,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2013 from the arts and cultural heritage
1.7	fund to the governing board of the Minnesota Historical Society to preserve and enhance
1.8	access to Minnesota's history and its cultural and historical resources. Grant agreements
1.9	entered into by the Minnesota Historical Society and other recipients of appropriations
1.10	under this section must ensure that these funds are used to supplement and not substitute
1.11	for traditional sources of funding. Funds directly appropriated to the Minnesota Historical
1.12	Society shall be used to supplement, and not substitute for, traditional sources of funding.
1.13	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.28, for historic preservation projects
