1.4 Section 1. LABOR AGREEMENTS AND COMPENSATION PLANS.

	Subd. 12. Managerial plan. The managerial plan, submitted to the Legislative
(Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations on March 2, 2020, is
1	ratified, except that the 2.5 percent general salary increase effective July 1, 2020, is not
1	ratified and must not be implemented.
	Subd. 13. Office of Higher Education Compensation Plan. The Office of Higher
	Education Unclassified Personnel Compensation Plan, submitted to the Legislative
(Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations on March 2, 2020, is
1	ratified, except that the 2.5 percent general salary increase effective July 1, 2020, is not
1	ratified and must not be implemented.
	Subd. 14. Compensation plan for MNsure. The compensation plan for MNsure,
-	submitted to the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations
•	on March 2, 2020, is ratified, except that the 2.5 percent general salary increase effective
•	July 1, 2020, is not ratified and must not be implemented.
	Subd. 15. MnSCU Personnel Plan for Administrators. The MnSCU Personnel Plan
	for Administrators, submitted to the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee
(on Employee Relations on December 10, 2019, as supplemented by the April 21, 2020,
1	memorandum by the Chancellor to the Leadership Council, is ratified.
	Subd. 16. Minnesota State University Association of Administrative and Service
-	Faculty. The labor agreement between the state of Minnesota and the Minnesota State
	University Association of Administrative and Service Faculty, submitted to the Legislative
(Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations on December 5, 2019, is
1	ratified, except that the 1.5 percent enhancement to the salary schedule effective July 8,
-	2020, is not ratified and must not be implemented.
	Subd. 17. Contingent provision. This subdivision applies if it is determined that the
	legislature does not have authority to ratify a labor agreement with the exceptions stated in

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- this section, or if it is determined that there is no longer a contract between the state and an exclusive representative of state employees due to this section. If this subdivision applies, then until the parties enter into a subsequent labor agreement, the terms and conditions of employment for employees covered by the proposed labor agreement are as contained in the agreement submitted to the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations, except that any provision in conflict with this section is not effective and must not be implemented.
