1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to consumer protection; requiring disclosure of used motor vehicle pricing;
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 325F.662, by adding a subdivision.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 325F.662, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 8b. Price disclosure. (a) A dealer must prominently display the price of a used
1.8 motor vehicle so that a consumer has access to the price before expressing interest in the
1.9 used motor vehicle or engaging in a transaction to purchase the used motor vehicle.

1.10 (b) For purposes of this subdivision, a dealer prominently displays a used motor vehicle's
1.11 price by: (1) displaying the vehicle's price in large print on the vehicle's windshield; (2)
1.12 clearly indicating the price on the dealer's website; or (3) any other equivalent means that
1.13 provides a consumer adequate notice of the vehicle's price without directly engaging the
1.14 dealer or one of the dealer's employees.
