1.5	Section 1. <u>DEPUTY REGISTRAR REIMBURSEMENTS.</u>
1.6	(a) \$6,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 is appropriated from the driver services operating
1.7	account in the special revenue fund to the commissioner of public safety for grants to deputy
1.8	registrars under Minnesota Statutes, section 168.33. This is a onetime appropriation and is
1.9	available in fiscal year 2019.
1.10	(b) The commissioner must reimburse each deputy registrar on a monthly basis for
1.11	eligible expenditures.
1.12	(c) Eligible expenditures under this section are documented expenses that are:
