1.6	Section 1. [103F.226] PUBLIC ROAD END; PROHIBITED USE.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section, "public road end" means the
1.8	terminus at a lake, pond, flowage, river, or stream of a road that is lawfully open for use by
1.9	the public.
1.10	Subd. 2. Prohibition. A public road end must not be used for any of the following unless
1.11	a recorded deed, recorded easement, or other recorded dedication expressly provides
1.12	otherwise:
1.13	(1) constructing, installing, maintaining, or using boat hoists or boat anchorage devices;
1.14	(2) mooring or docking a boat between midnight and sunrise;
1.15	(3) activity that obstructs ingress to or egress from the body of water; or
1.16	(4) constructing, installing, maintaining, or using a dock or wharf other than a single
1.17	seasonal public dock or wharf that is owned and maintained by a municipality or county.
1.18	Subd. 3. Enforcement. A person who violates subdivision 2 is guilty of a misdemeanor.
1.19	Each day on which the violation continues or is repeated constitutes a separate offense.
