1.8	for voting or elections purposes must conform to the requirements of section 508 of
1.9	the Rehabilitation Act, United States Code, title 29, section 794d, and Title II of the
1.10	Americans with Disabilities Act, United States Code, title 42, sections 12131 to 12165,
1.11	to ensure equal access to voters with disabilities. Access experts shall be included in the
1.12	development of any new Web site prior to its establishment and the accessibility of all
1.13	existing Web sites must be verified and certified accessible by an independent body with
1.14	expertise in accessibility issues no later than January 1, 2015.
