Section 1. OFF-SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE; HUBBARD COUNTY.

Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.405, subdivision 2, paragraph (e),
the Hubbard County Board may issue an off-sale intoxicating liquor license to an exclusive liquor store located in Akeley Township. All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this section, apply to the license authorized under this section.
