1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 124D.09, subdivision 9, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 9. Enrollment priority. A postsecondary institution shall give priority to its
1.8	postsecondary students when enrolling 10th, 11th, and 12th grade pupils in its courses.
1.9	A postsecondary institution may provide information about its programs to a secondary
1.10	school or to a pupil or parent and it may advertise or otherwise reeruit or solicit a
1.11	secondary pupil to enroll in its programs on educational and programmatic grounds only.
1.12	An institution must not enroll secondary pupils, for postsecondary enrollment options
1.13	purposes, in remedial, developmental, or other courses that are not college level. Once a
1.14	pupil has been enrolled in a postsecondary course under this section, the pupil shall not
1.15	be displaced by another student.
