BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **RANIER; SAFE HARBOR TRANSIENT BOAT DOCK ON RAINY**
- 1.6

LAKE.
- 1.7

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$917,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.8

to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Ranier to predesign, design,
- 1.9

engineer, construct, and equip a marina to provide up to 26 slips in a safe harbor on Rainy
- 1.10

Lake and Rainy River at the Gateway to Voyageurs National Park. The marina will provide
- 1.11

overnight transient boaters with water, electricity, and sewage pump out services. This
- 1.12

appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.
- 1.13

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.14

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.15

the state in an amount up to \$917,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.16

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.17

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
