1.9	(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the legislature preempts all authority
1.10	of a home rule charter or statutory city including a city of the first class, county, town,
1.11	municipal corporation, or other governmental subdivision, or any of their instrumentalities,
1.12	to regulate firearms, ammunition, or their respective components to the complete exclusion
1.13	of any order, ordinance or regulation by them except that:
1.14	(a) (1) a governmental subdivision may regulate the discharge of firearms; and
1.15	(b) (2) a governmental subdivision may adopt regulations identical to state law.
1.16	(b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to a local unit of government acting to further a
1.17	clearly stated public safety purpose and achieve a clearly stated public safety outcome.
