1.9	Metropolitan Council, a metropolitan or regional agency, or an entity in the executive,
1.10	judicial, or legislative branch of state government.
1.11	Subd. 2. Prohibition. An agency must not offer or provide to any person a gift of money
1.12	or property as an inducement to respond to a public survey. An agency must not allow an
1.13	entity conducting a public survey on behalf of the agency to offer or provide a gift of money
1.14	or property as an inducement to respond to the survey.
