1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 16C.02, subdivision 21, is amended to read:
Subd. 21. Vendor. "Vendor" means a business or nonprofit organization, including
a construction contractor or a natural person, and includes both if the natural person is
engaged in a business or nonprofit organization.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 16C.16, subdivision 5, is amended to read: 1.10 Subd. 5. Designation of targeted groups. (a) The commissioner of administration 1.11 shall periodically designate businesses that are majority owned and operated by women, 1.12 persons with a substantial physical disability, or specific minorities as targeted group 1.13 businesses within purchasing categories as determined by the commissioner. A group 1.14 may be targeted within a purchasing category if the commissioner determines there is a 1.15 statistical disparity between the percentage of purchasing from businesses owned by 1.16 group members and the representation of businesses owned by group members among all 1.17 businesses in the state in the purchasing category. 1.18 (b) In addition to designations under paragraph (a), an individual business may be

included as a targeted group business if the commissioner determines that inclusion is
necessary to remedy discrimination against the owner based on race, gender, or disability
in attempting to operate a business that would provide goods or services to public agencies.
