1.6	Section 1. MOORHEAD; 11TH STREET RAIL GRADE CROSSING.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$7,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Moorhead for predesign,
1.9	environmental assessment, environmental work, design, engineering, utility relocation, and
1.10	acquisition of property for a rail grade crossing separation in the vicinity of 11th Street in
1.11	the city of Moorhead. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management
1.12	and budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project
1.13	as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
1.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
