1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; providing for trapping licenses without fee for disabled
1.3 veterans; amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 97A.441, by adding a
1.4 subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 97A.441, is amended by adding a
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 6b. **Trapping fur-bearing animals; disabled veterans.** Upon being
1.9 furnished satisfactory evidence, a person authorized to issue licenses must issue, without a
1.10 fee, a license to trap fur-bearing animals to a resident who is a veteran, as defined in section
1.11 197.447, and who has a 100 percent service-connected disability as defined by the United
1.12 States Veterans Administration. For a license that must be obtained through a drawing, the
1.13 veteran must also furnish evidence of having been selected through the drawing.
