1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 161.14, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8 to read:

1.9 Subd. 83. Medal of Honor recipient Kenneth L. Olson Highway. That segment of

1.10 marked Trunk Highway 23 within the city of Paynesville and the town of Paynesville is

1.11 designated as "Medal of Honor recipient Kenneth L. Olson Highway." Subject to section

1.12 161.139, the commissioner shall adopt a suitable design to mark this highway and erect

1.13 appropriate signs.
