1.5 1.6	Section 1. <u>DIRECTION TO LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR; DEPARTMENT OF</u> HUMAN SERVICES.
1.7	The legislative auditor shall conduct or contract with an independent third-party vendor
1.8	to conduct a comprehensive program audit and financial audit within the Department of
1.9	Human Services. The audit shall be conducted in accordance with generally accepted
1.10	government auditing standards issued by the United States Government Accountability
1.11	Office. The legislative auditor shall complete the audit no later than July 1, 2021, and shall
1.12	report the results of the audit, including suggested program and internal policy changes to
1.13	improve integrity and overall agency function, to the chairs and ranking minority members
1.14	of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services finance and
1.15	policy by February 1, 2022.
