1.8	modifying and improving the guidelines. Any modification which amends the Sentencing
1.9	Guidelines grid, including severity levels and criminal history scores, or which would result
1.10	in the reduction of any sentence or in the early release of any inmate, with the exception of
1.11	a modification mandated or authorized by the legislature or relating to a crime created or
1.12	amended by the legislature in the preceding session, shall be submitted to the legislature by
