1.8	payment rates shall be increased by ten percent over the rates in effect on January 1, 2014,
1.9	for vendors who meet the requirements of section 254B.05.
1.10	(b) The commissioner shall adjust rates paid to prepaid health plans under contract
1.11	with the commissioner to reflect the rate increase provided in paragraph (a). The prepaid
1.12	health plan must pass this rate increase to the providers identified in paragraph (a).
