1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 169.475, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. Prohibition on use; penalty. (a) No person may operate a motor vehicle while
1.8	using a wireless communications device to compose, read, or send an electronic message,
1.9	when the vehicle is in motion or a part of traffic. For the purposes of this section, "using a
1.10	wireless communications device" includes: (1) composing, reading, or sending an electronic
1.11	message; (2) dialing, answering, or talking on a cellular phone; and (3) otherwise making
1.12	a cellular phone call.
1.13	(b) A person who violates paragraph (a) a second or subsequent time must pay a fine of
1.14	\$225, plus the amount specified in the uniform fine schedule established by the Judicial
1.15	Council.
1.16	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2017, and applies to violations
