1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 116.07, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7	to read:
1.8	Subd. 7f. Temporary grain storage facility; fugitive emissions standards. (a)
1.9	Minnesota Rules, part 7011.1005, does not apply to operations of a commodity facility that
1.10	use portable equipment to handle grain stored in a temporary storage facility.
1.11	(b) For the purposes of this subdivision, the following terms have the meanings given
1.12	them:
1.13	(1) "temporary storage facility" means a facility storing grain that:
1.14	(i) uses an asphalt, concrete, or comparable base material;
1.15	(ii) has rigid, self-supporting sidewalls;
1.16	(iii) provides adequate aeration; and
1.17	(iv) provides an acceptable covering; and
1.18	(2) "portable equipment" means equipment that is not fixed at any one spot and can be
1.19	moved, including but not limited to portable augers, portable conveyers, and portable
1.20	front-end loaders.
