1.6	Section 1. [62Q.481] CO-PAYMENTS FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS TO TREAT
1.7	CHRONIC DISEASE.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Co-payment limit. A health plan that imposes co-payments on the
1.9	coverage of prescription drugs must limit the amount of any co-payment to \$25 per
1.10	one-month supply for prescription drugs prescribed to treat a chronic disease and related
1.11	medical supplies necessary to administer the prescription drugs.
1.12	Subd. 2. Definition of chronic disease. For purposes of this section, "chronic disease"
1.13	means diabetes, asthma, and allergies requiring the use of epinephrine auto-injectors.
1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2024, and applies to health
1.15	plans offered, issued, and renewed on or after that date.
