2.1 (1) assaults a reserve officer as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, paragraph (e),
2.2 or a community service officer, who is engaged in the performance of official public duties
2.3 at the direction of, under the control of, or on behalf of a peace officer or supervising law
2.4 enforcement officer or agency; and

2.5 (2) should reasonably know that the victim is a reserve officer or community service
2.6 officer engaged in the performance of official public duties of the peace officer, or
2.7 supervising law enforcement officer or agency.

2.8 (b) As used in this subdivision, "community service officer" means an individual, not
2.9 licensed by the Board of Peace Officer Standards and Training, authorized by ordinance to
2.10 wear the uniform of a law enforcement agency and perform general-duty civilian public
2.11 safety work.

2.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2018, and applies to violations
2.13 committed on or after that date.
