1.10	in violation of subdivision 2 is guilty of a misdemeanor.
1.11	(b) A person who violates paragraph (a) after being previously convicted or adjudicated
1.12	delinquent for violating paragraph (a) is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
1.13	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2022, and applies to crimes
