1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. THE NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT CENTER; APPROPRIATION.
1.6	(a) \$9,500,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the Neighborhood
1.8	Development Center. This is a onetime appropriation.
1.9	(b) Of the amount appropriated:
1.10	(1) \$2,000,000 is for the Neighborhood Development Center's current and new small
1.11	business incubators to assist with capital investment needs;
1.12	(2) \$1,000,000 is to support the development of small business incubators outside the
1.13	seven-county metropolitan area as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 473.121, subdivision
1.14	<u>2;</u>
1.15	(3) \$1,000,000 is to leverage additional loan dollars in recourse lending capital and for
1.16	loan loss reserve for high-risk lending to mitigate losses;
1.17	(4) \$3,500,000 is for real estate lending capital to assist entrepreneurs to purchase
1.18	commercial properties or to redevelop a property already owned by an entrepreneur; and
1.19	(5) \$2,000,000 is for nonrecourse lending capital for low-income entrepreneurs, with
1.20	an emphasis on BIPOC entrepreneurs, with loan payment schedules and terms customized
