- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. **ONLINE HOSPITALITY TRAINING PROGRAM; APPROPRIATION.**
- 1.6\$250,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
- 1.7of employment and economic development for a grant to a postsecondary education
- 1.8institution located in the state for the creation and operation of an online hospitality training
- 1.9program in partnership with Explore Minnesota Tourism. This training program must be
- 1.10made available at no cost to Minnesota residents in an effort to address critical workforce
- 1.11shortages and assist in career development. This is a onetime appropriation.
