1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a pedestrian bridge over a
1.3 highway in Forest Lake; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. FOREST LAKE; PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,200,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7 to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Forest Lake to design, engineer,
1.8 and construct a pedestrian bridge over marked Trunk Highway 97 at Goodview Avenue in
1.9 Forest Lake. The project also includes design, engineering, and construction of the
1.10 approaching trails that will add a connection to the nearby 34-mile Hardwood Creek Regional
1.11 Trail. This appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.

1.12 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14 the state in an amount up to \$3,200,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
