1.2 relating to human services; modifying background study fees for child care
1.3 programs; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2017 Supplement,
1.4 section 245C.10, subdivision 9a.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2017 Supplement, section 245C.10, subdivision 9a, is
1.7 amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 9a. Child care programs. The commissioner shall recover the cost of a background
1.9 study required for family child care, certified license-exempt child care centers, licensed
1.10 child care centers, and legal nonlicensed child care providers authorized under chapter 119B
1.11 through a fee of no more than \$40 per study charged to the license holder. The fees collected
1.12 under this subdivision are appropriated to the commissioner to conduct background studies.
1.13 The commissioner shall not recover more than \$160 from a single family child care provider
1.14 for the costs of background studies for child care staff persons, as defined in section 245C.02.

1.15 Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION.

1.16 \$...... in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of
1.17 human services for the costs of family child care background studies exceeding \$160 per
1.18 family child care provider, under Minnesota Statutes, section 245C.10, subdivision 9a.
